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
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A Note from Mike Sutton, President & CEO



Milestone Dedication **700th Home Build**

Habitat Pinellas and West Pasco has been a driving force and advocate for affordable homeownership opportunities in our community since 1985. Out of 1,100 Habitat for Humanity affiliates across the country, the organization is ranked 2nd based on new home builds. We are one month away from celebrating home #700! This milestone home is located in Tellor Estates, Pinellas Park, our largest development to date.



Habitat Milestones



As part of an ongoing effort to bring affordable homeownership opportunities to the area's working-class neighborhoods, Habitat Pinellas and West Pasco continues to work with the City of Pinellas Park and community partners to build homes in Tellor Estates, the affiliate's largest development to date.

In June of 2018, Habitat Pinellas and West Pasco acquired 7.3 acres located at the northeast corner of 68th Street and 62nd Avenue North in Pinellas Park for \$2.1 million. The following summer, the affiliate commemorated the groundbreaking with elected officials, homeowners and supporters.

Over the past two years, immense growth has taken place in Tellor Estates. At this time, we have completed 28 new homes in addition to the construction of a new road, with a total investment exceeding \$5,200,000. Upon completion, the neighborhood will offer 75 local families and individuals the opportunity to improve the paths of their family for generations to come.

Habitat Pinellas and West Pasco will celebrate our 700th Home Build in Pinellas Park on August 30th, 2021. Since launching the campaign to support this home build, we have surpassed our goal of 100 donors at \$700!

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Education Center Coming Soon

In May, we celebrated the grand opening of our new Administrative Headquarters near the St. Pete-Clearwater Airport. This move of staff from the Clearwater ReStore offices allows for the build out of a dedicated Education Center and Homeowner Selection Area, with an anticipated completion date of October 2021.

Homeowner education is at the core of the Habitat program. The decision to move the administrative offices was made with our homeowners in mind. The addition of a dedicated education center will enhance our program by providing a first-rate educational experience for our homeowners and our devoted instructors.

Special thanks to Truist, Tibbets, Republic Bank, The Trepani Family and Marion Rich for sponsoring this new addition.

The Truist Education Center featured a space will include a large conference room that will serve as the main education space. Homeowner candidates soon be able to gather for classes and have an in-person experience as they complete the curriculum. There are also three dedication rooms for one on one mentoring. These rooms have been generously sponsored by Republic Bank, the Trepani Family and Marion Rich.

The new Education Center will also feature a Homeowner Selection Area, sponsored by Tibbets Lumber. This showroom will provide a curated space for homeowners to meet with the Habitat construction team to visualize and discuss various design options for their new home. Homeowners will be able to pick paint colors, see a model mockup of their kitchen cabinets, get hands-on with other materials and view their floor plans.




Did you know?
