As we wrap up another calendar year, I am taking the time to reflect on the many accomplishments our affiliate has been able to achieve. In 2021, Habitat will complete 70 homes for deserving families throughout Pinellas and West Pasco Counties, compared to 61 the past year - no small feat while adjusting through a pandemic. For the fourth consecutive year, Pinellas & West Pasco is ranked as the second largest affiliate in the Habitat network, based on new home construction.

# **Education Center Ribbon Cutting**

On Wednesday, November 10th, Habitat for Humanity of Pinellas and West Pasco Counties proudly celebrated the ribbon cutting of the new Truist Foundation Homeowner Education Center. Education is the cornerstone of the Habitat Homeownership Program, and the buildout of this space will allow for greater impact throughout the community through homeownership education.

The new center located inside the Habitat Clearwater ReStore, features a large interactive classroom sponsored by Truist Foundation, a Homebuyer Selection Area sponsored by Tibbetts Lumber CO., and Breakout Rooms sponsored by Republic Bank Foundation, Marion Rich, and the Trepani Family. The transformation of the space allows for more enhancements to the ReStore, as it includes a space for available for purchase cabinets and vanities through a partnership with Lakeland Liquidation.

The transformation of the Education Center will be essential to the homeowners that come through the Habitat program. Habitat Board Members and Homeowners, Tamara DeBose and Davisha Earley, shared with attendees the importance of homeowner education during Wednesday's grand opening.

President and CEO, Mike Sutton, says "The decision to move the administrative offices earlier this year was made with our homeowners in mind. The addition of a dedicated education center will enhance our program by providing a first-rate educational experience for our homeowners and our devoted instructors."

# **Minimum Wage Jump**

In 2020, Habitat for Humanity of Pinellas and West Pasco Counties increased its minimum wage from \$13.50 an hour to \$15. Now we are doing more. By 2024, our hourly rate will increase to \$18. "Our board of directors and executive leadership team see this as an opportunity to lead the way for nonprofits to do our part to ensure our talent is making a livable wage," said Mike Sutton, president and CEO.

# **Community Leaders Build Day**

Roughly two dozen leaders from several Pinellas County communities, including Clearwater, Largo, Dunedin, Oldsmar, and Indian Rocks Beach, recently convened on a newly mapped side street in Pinellas Park, but not for a legislative meeting. Pinellas officials gathered on 67th Way North on Oct. 29 for Habitat for Humanities of Pinellas and West Pasco Counties Elected Officials Volunteer Build Dav.

"Through conversations with local elected officials, we discussed how to bring everyone together to talk about affordable home ownership," Sutton said during the three-hour session, which included painting, planting and other beautification projects and concluded with a lunchtime roundtable discussion on the topic. "We sent invites to all state and local elected officials, and we have about 25 here today helping us work on this house, so I think the response was extremely positive. It's really neat to see everyone coming together regardless of where we're building the house."

Advocacy is a key pillar for the Habitat for Humanity organization. Our affiliate is making a further commitment and investment advocating for the advancement of affordable homeownership in our community. Through advocacy, Habitat seeks to influence policy and promote affordability among the broader housing continuum.
