Welcome to the eighteenth edition of The Community Builder newsletter! This exclusive communication is specifically designed for you – our Advisory Board Members, Board of Directors, Emeritus Trustees, Legacy Society Members, Community Builders Society Members, and major donors. The goal of this monthly communication is to provide you with insight into current and upcoming projects, events and initiatives designed in support of our mission.

I want to thank our generous supporters for an impactful 2022. Because of your support, Habitat has served 790 families and are on the way to #800 as we kick off 2023! Here's a snapshot of affiliate successes:

- Habitat has built 66 new homes over the past 12 months!
- The affiliate's impact was recognized by several organizations with community awards including:
 - Once again recognized as a One Tampa Bay honoree by the Tampa Bay Business Journal
 - Amplify Clearwater's Nonprofit Excellence Award
 - Pinellas Park Chamber of Commerce's Nonprofit of the Year
 - Greater Pasco Chamber of Commerce's Service Organization of the Year
- We received the Energy Star Market Award for our energy savings construction techniques.
- We reached the \$3M tithe milestone this year and have now built more than 700 homes internationally.
- After four consecutive years ranked as the second largest affiliate based on new home construction, out of 1,000 affiliates within the Habitat network, we ended FY2023 with 67 homes completed, making us the largest affiliate in the network for the year!
- We've grown our staff to 74 individuals all bringing a wide range of diversity & backgrounds to the table and focused on meeting the goals of our organization.
- We opened our new New Port Richey ReStore location!

As we embark on a new year, I wish you and your family a blessed 2023. Thank you for your ongoing partnership. Together, we will build homes, communities and hope.
